### Investment Objectives and Approach

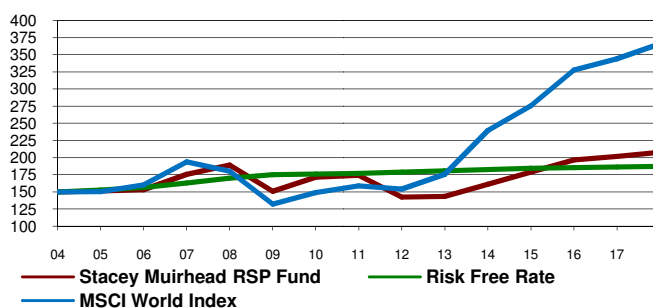
The objective of the Stacey Muirhead RSP Fund is to generate real absolute returns for unitholders over the long term. The Fund utilizes a global, value, multi-strategy investment approach. The Fund makes long term, event driven and distressed credit investments. The Fund will also hold cash, usually short term treasury bills, when it has excess capital, and will take positions in an effort to mitigate identifiable risks where appropriate.

March 1, 2004 – August 31, 2017 (in 000's)



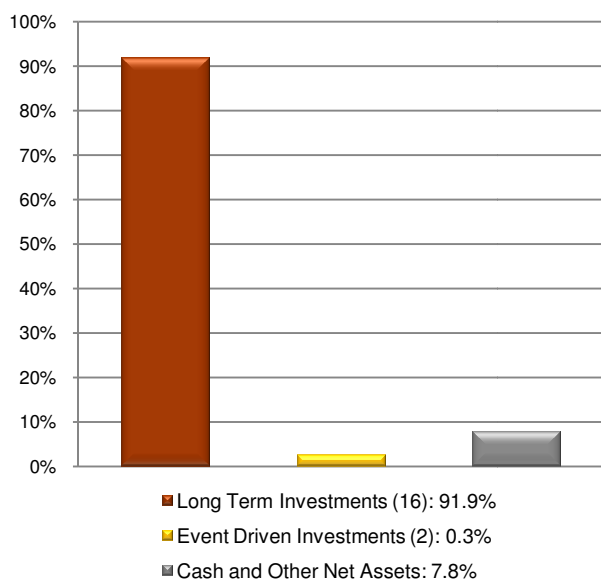

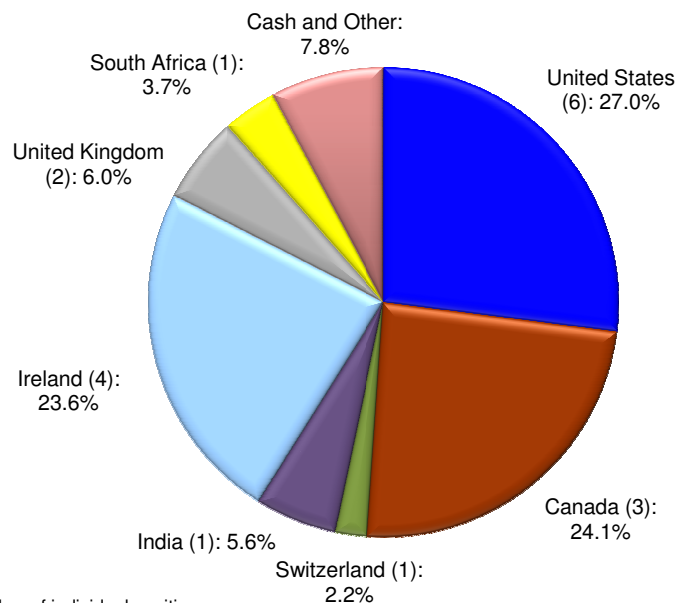
### Portfolio Composition – as of June 30, 2017
