Investment Objectives and Approach

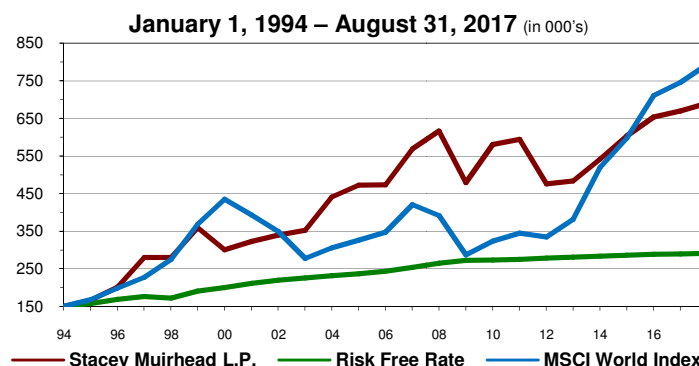

The Partnership will also hold cash, usually short term treasury bills, when it has excess capital, and will take positions in an effort to mitigate identifiable risks where appropriate.

Growth of a \$150,000 Investment

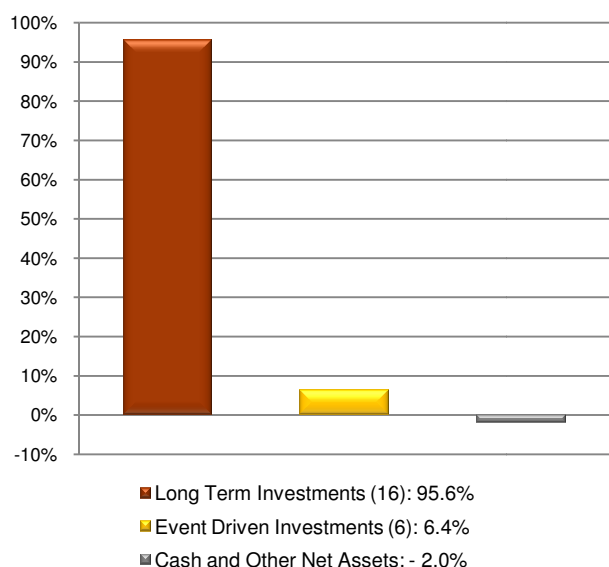

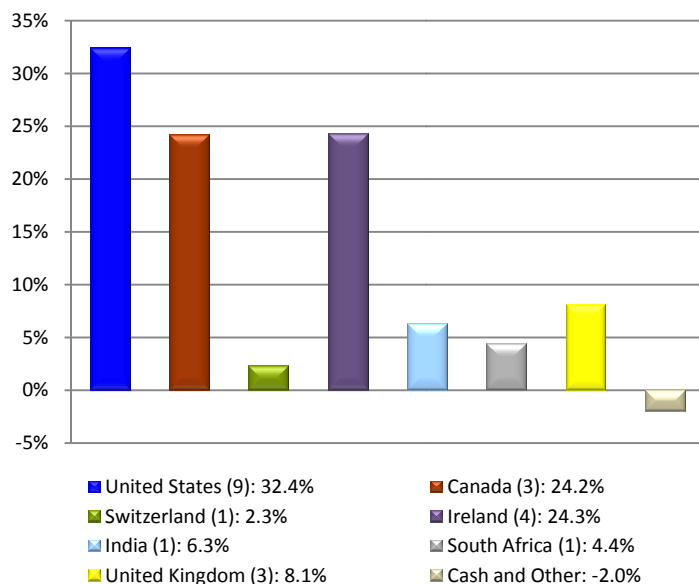
